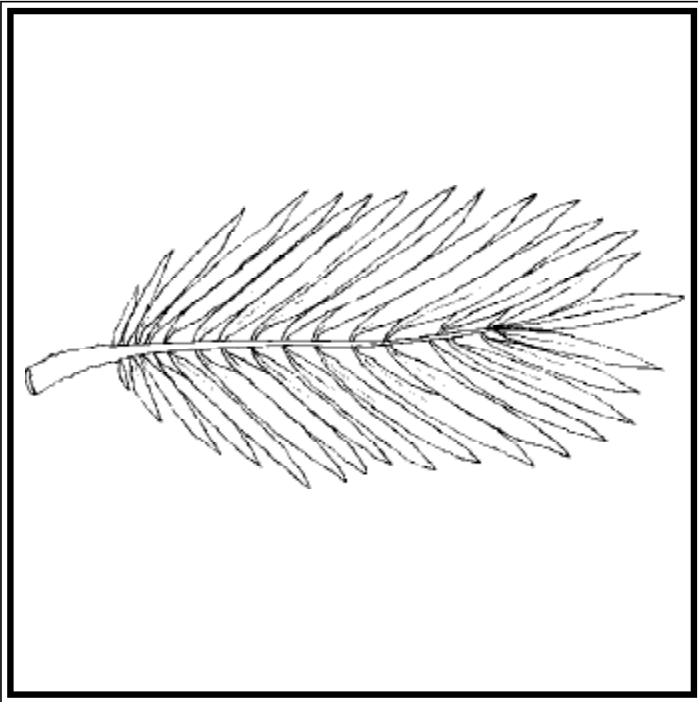
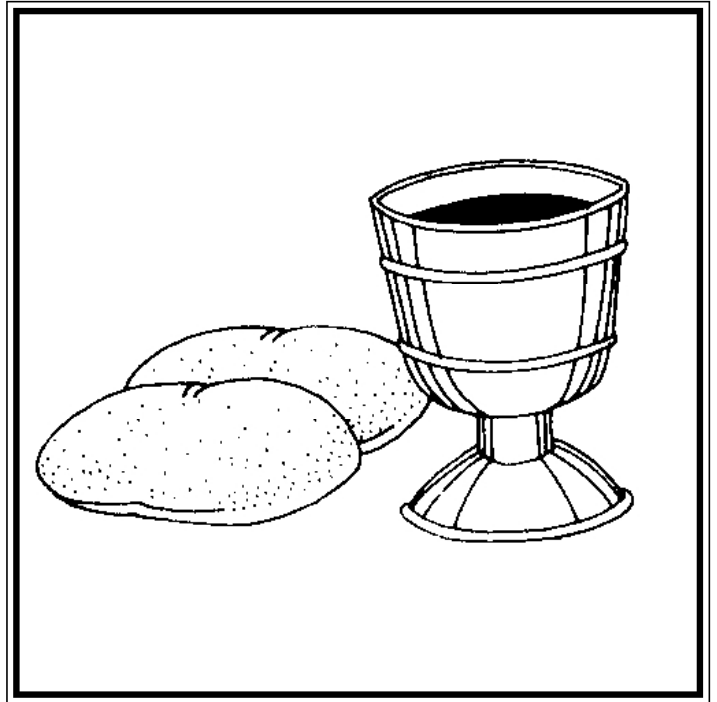


Do you know about Holy Week?

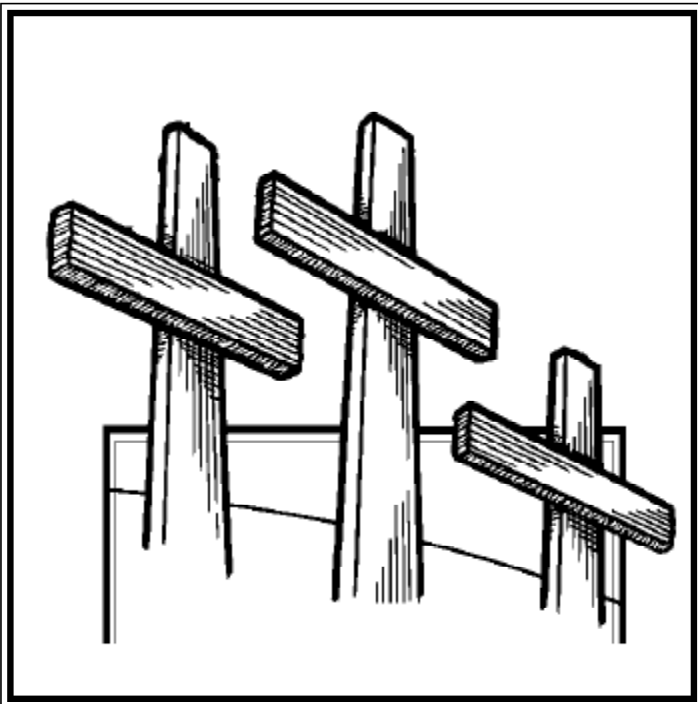
Color the pictures and learn about the last week before the first Easter. Ask your parents to help tell the story to you this week.



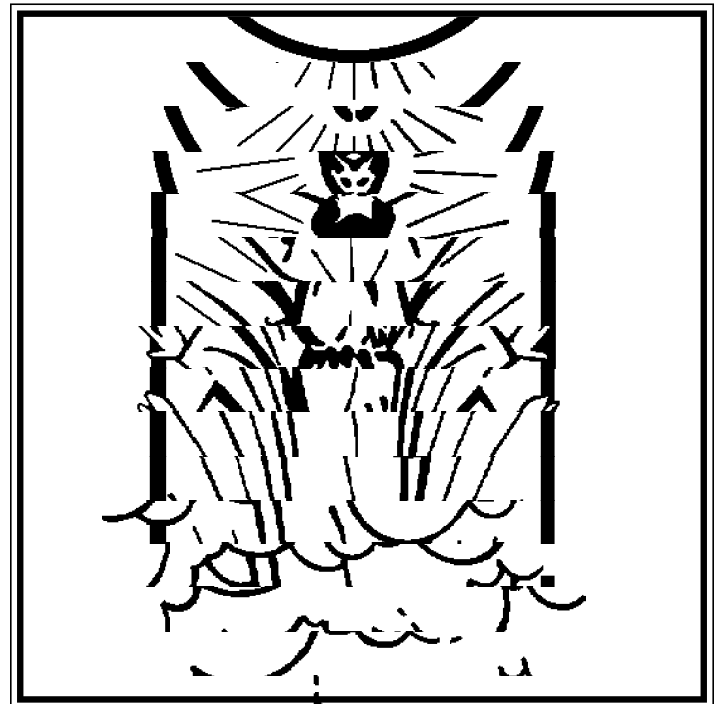

Jesus told the story of the Prodigal Son to teach us that God still loves us when we do wrong, but he wants us to come back to him.

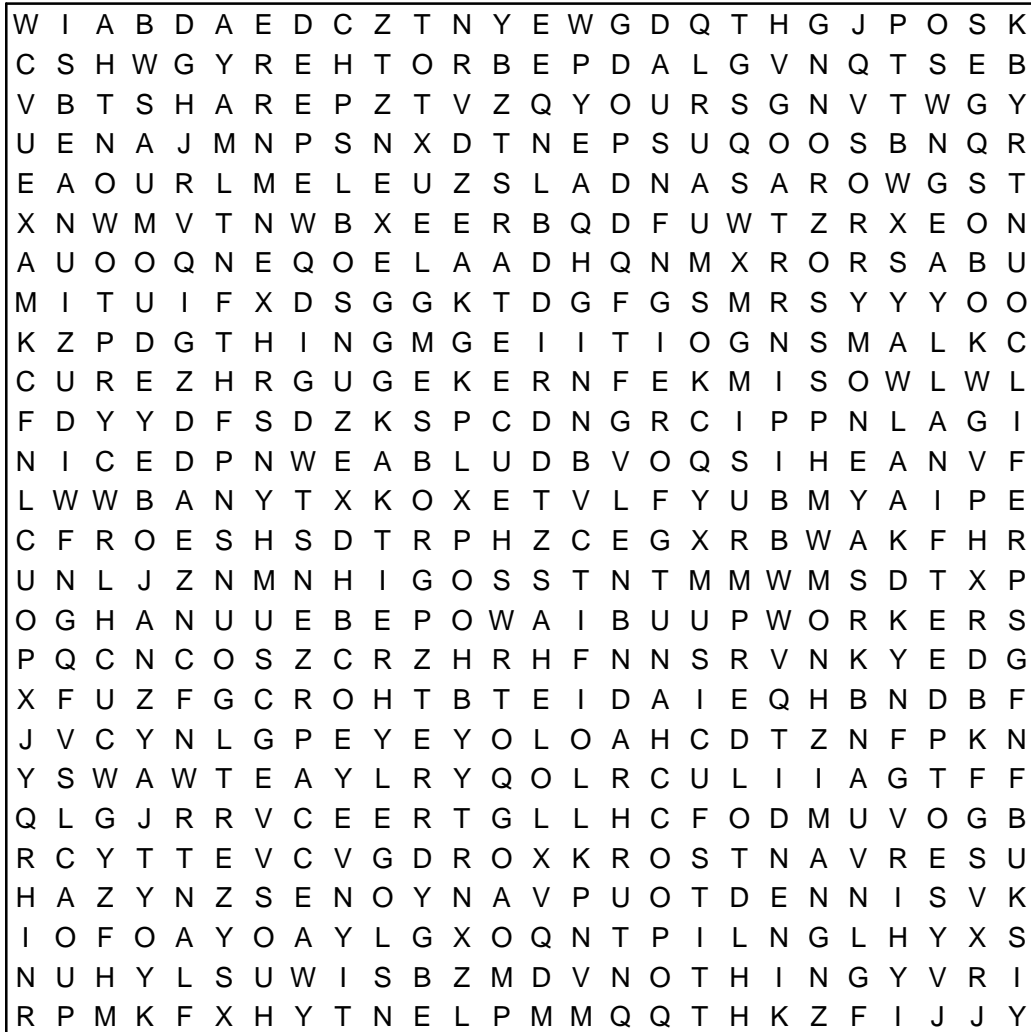
The son is sorry he had done wrong.
