

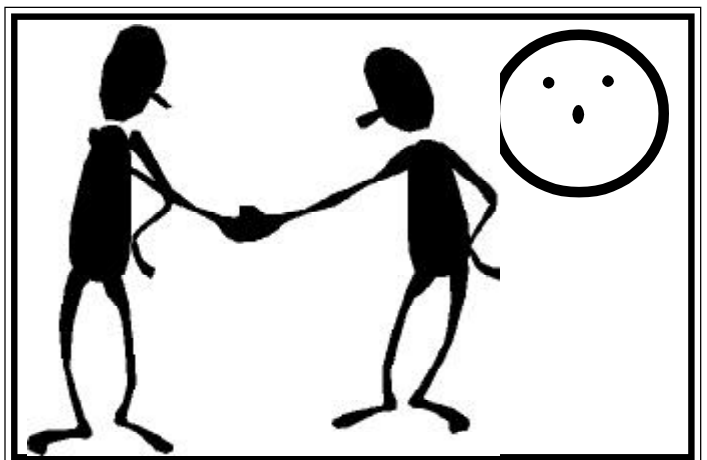
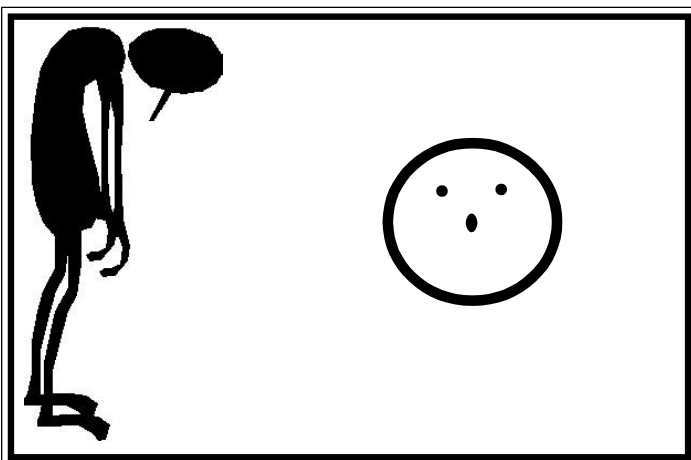
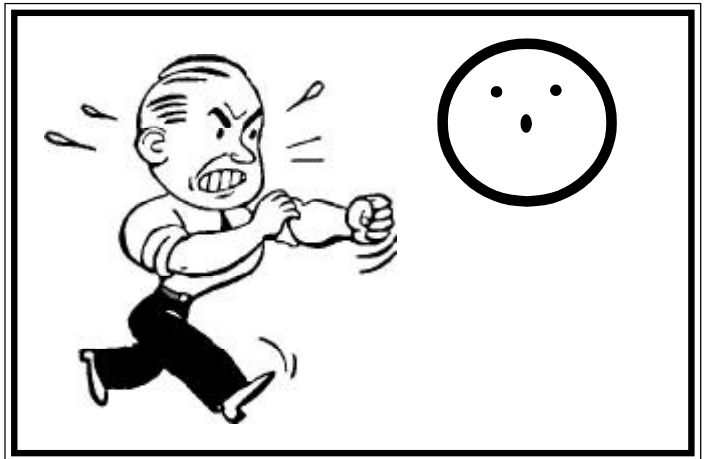
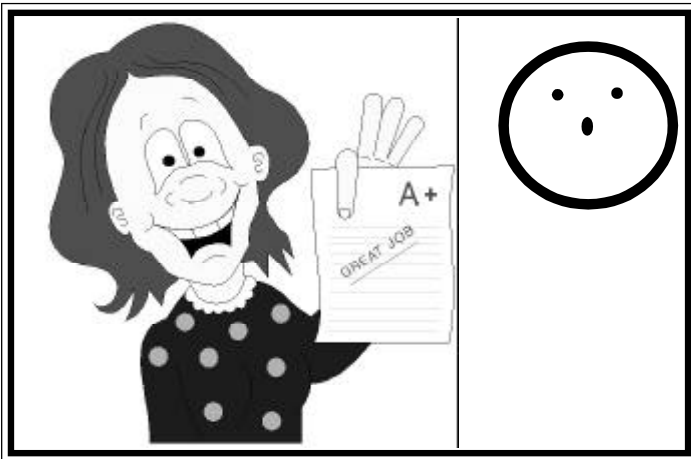
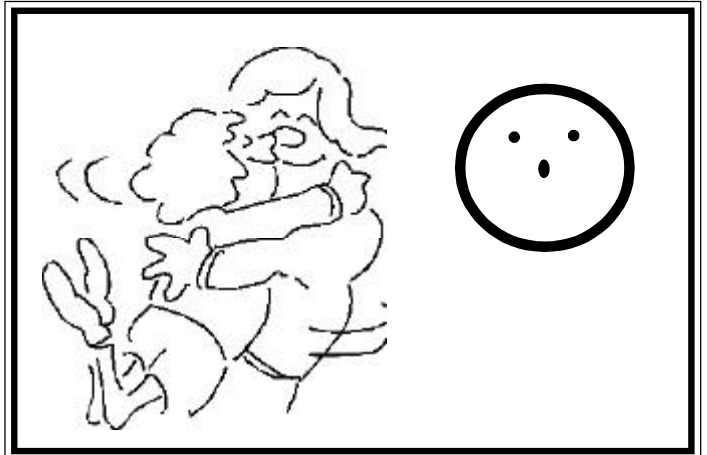
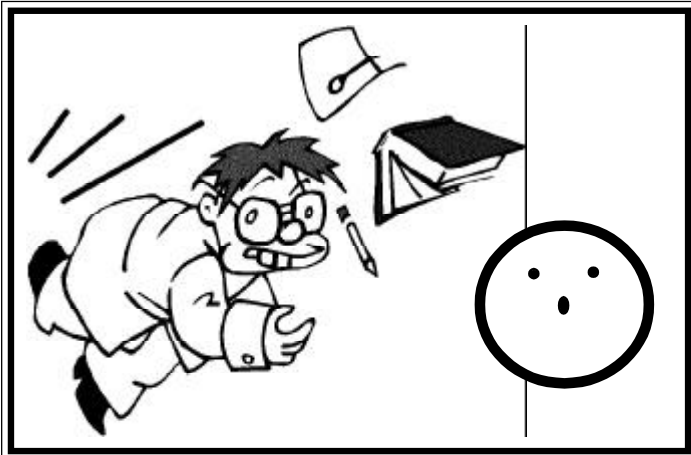




Happy or Sad?
