

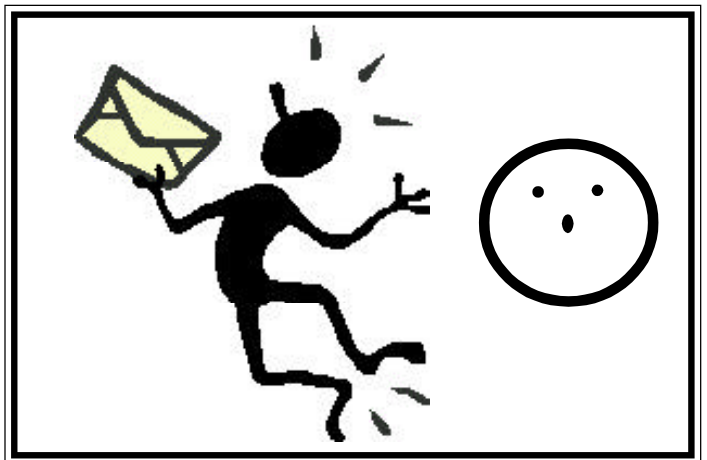
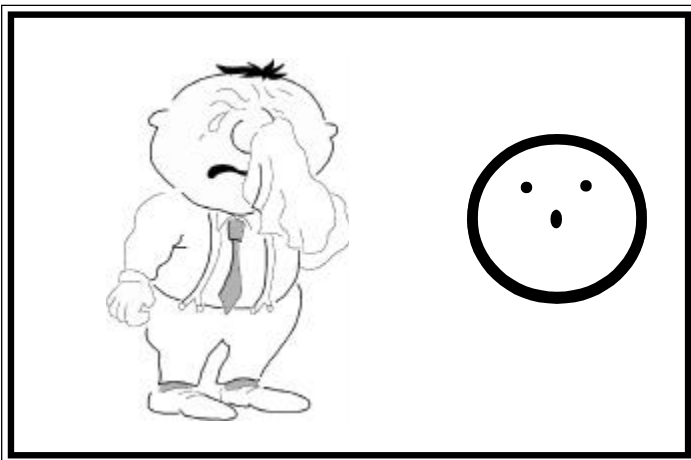
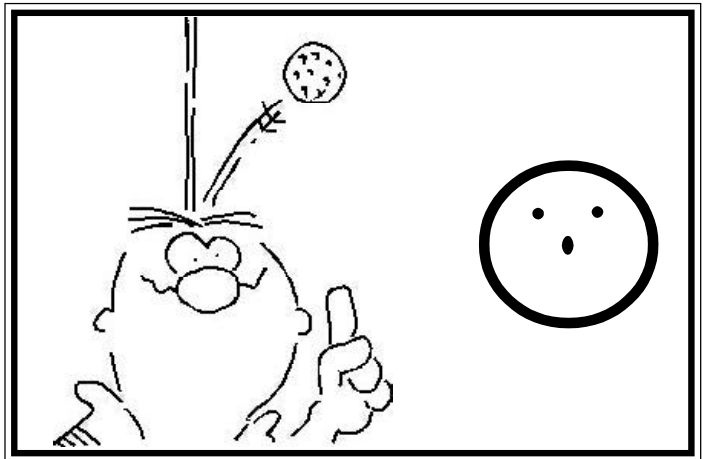
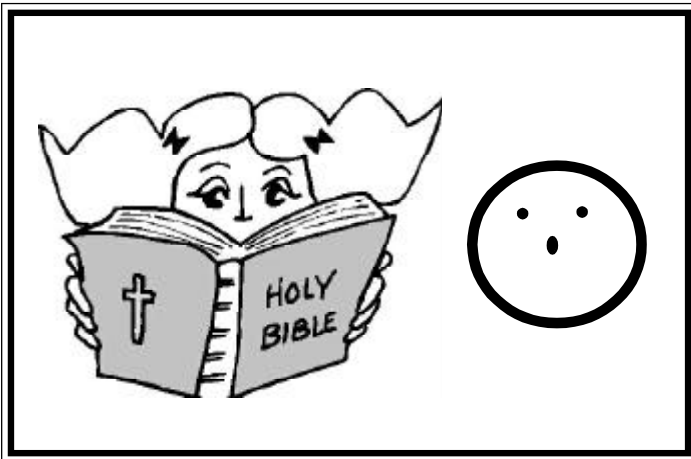
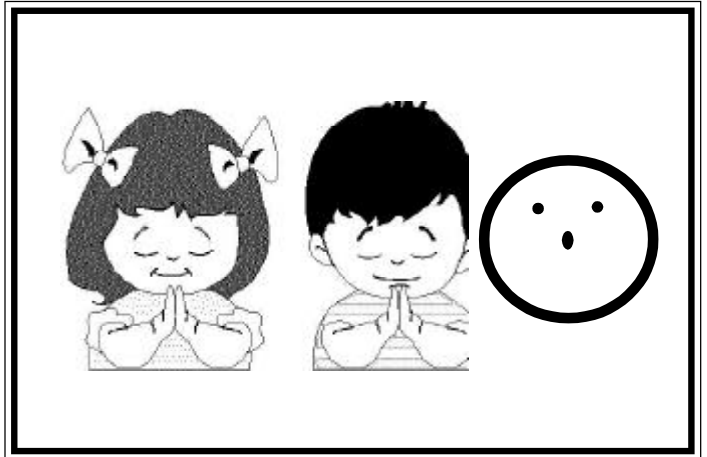
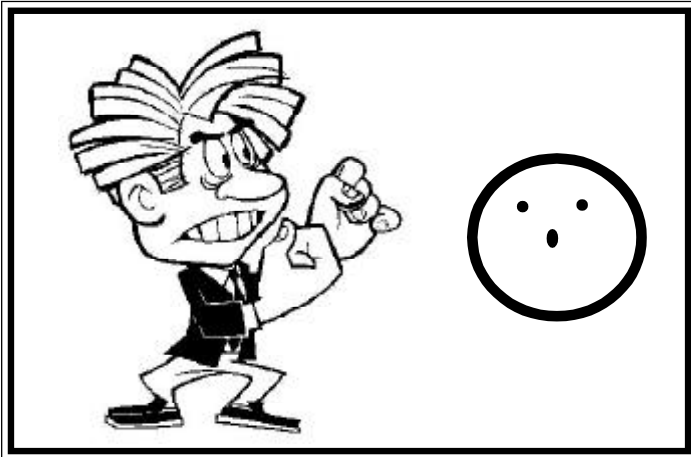




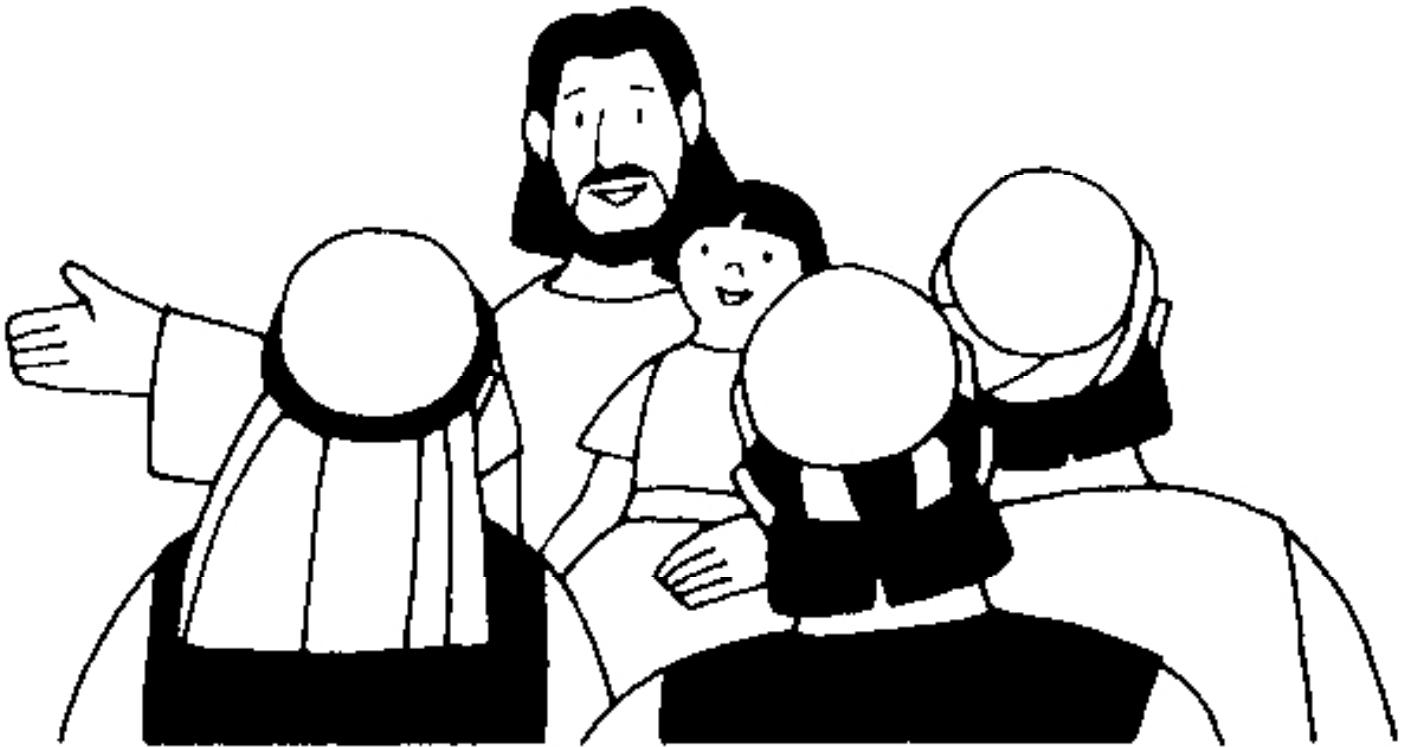
Happy or Sad?
