

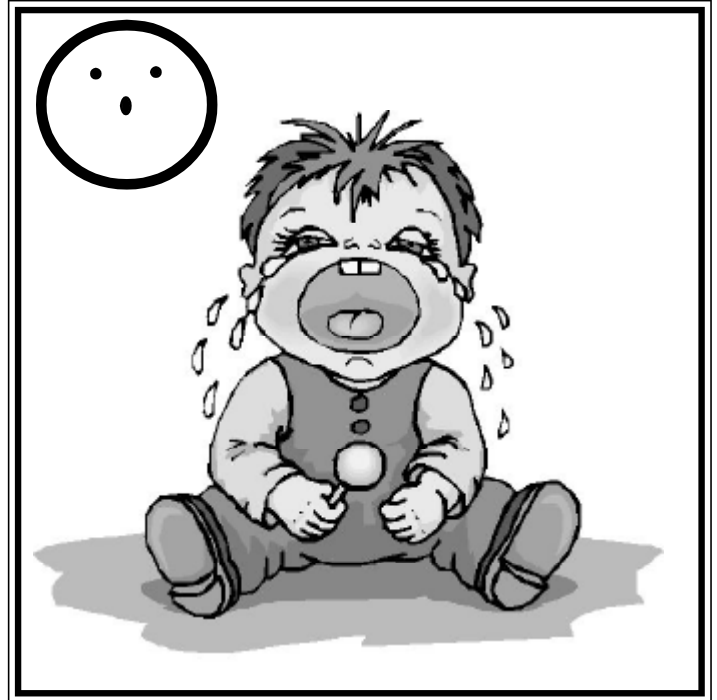
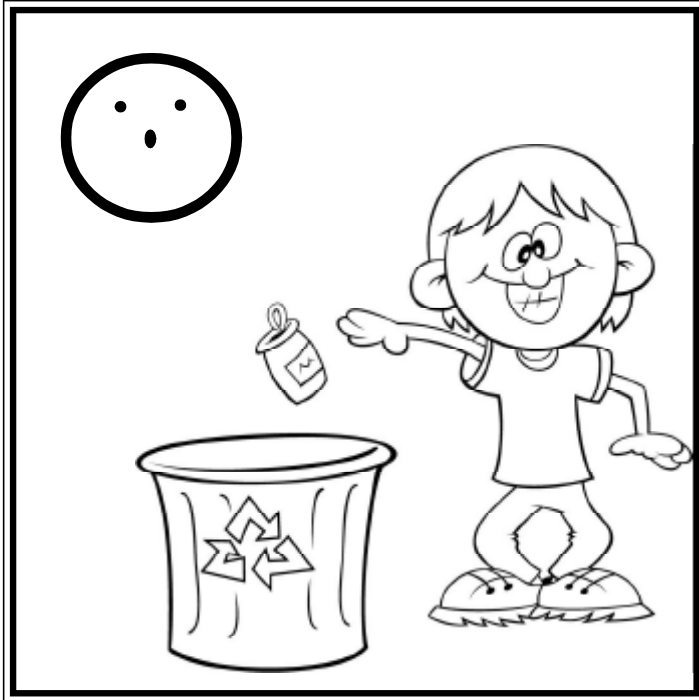




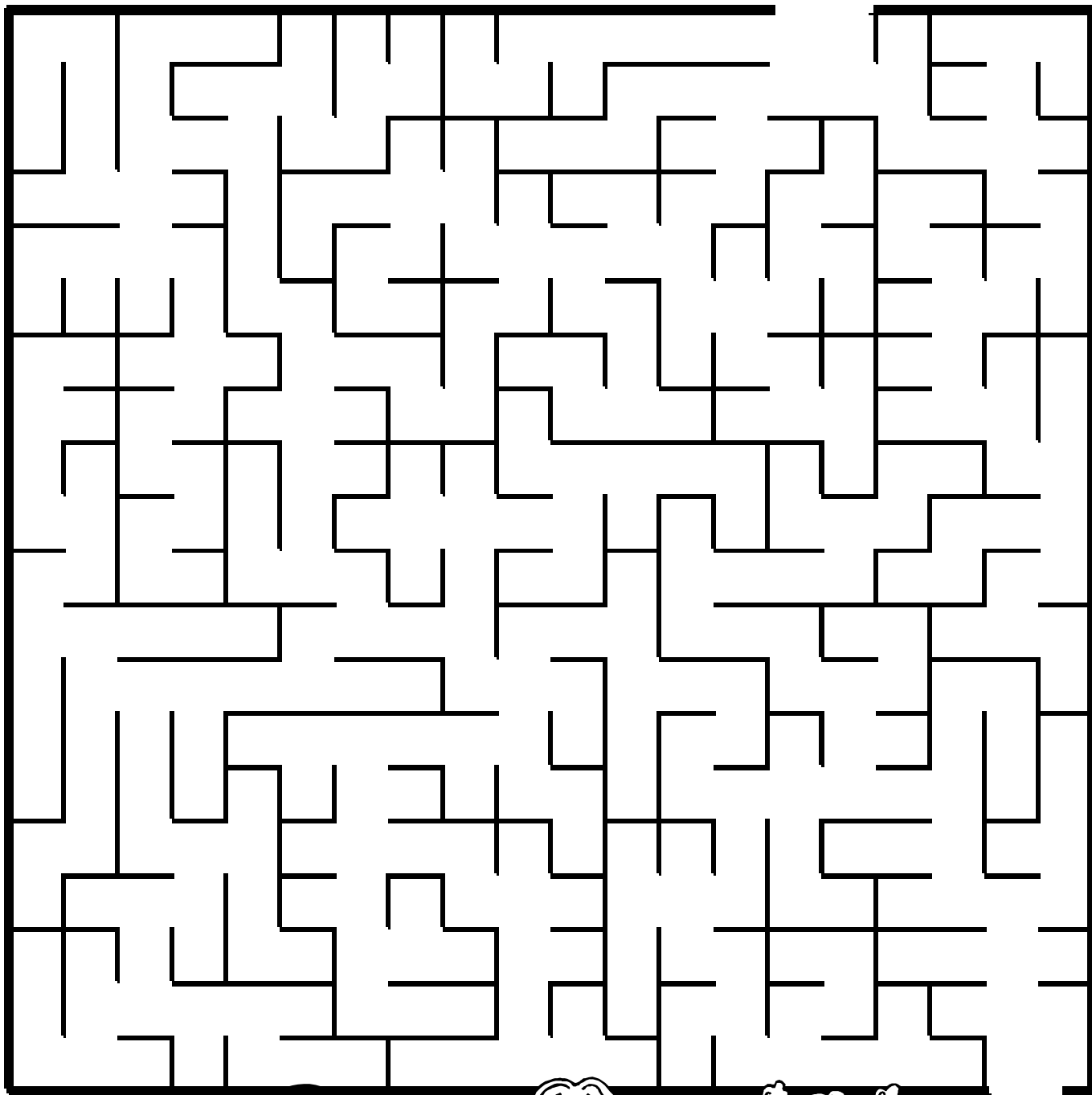
Happy or Sad?



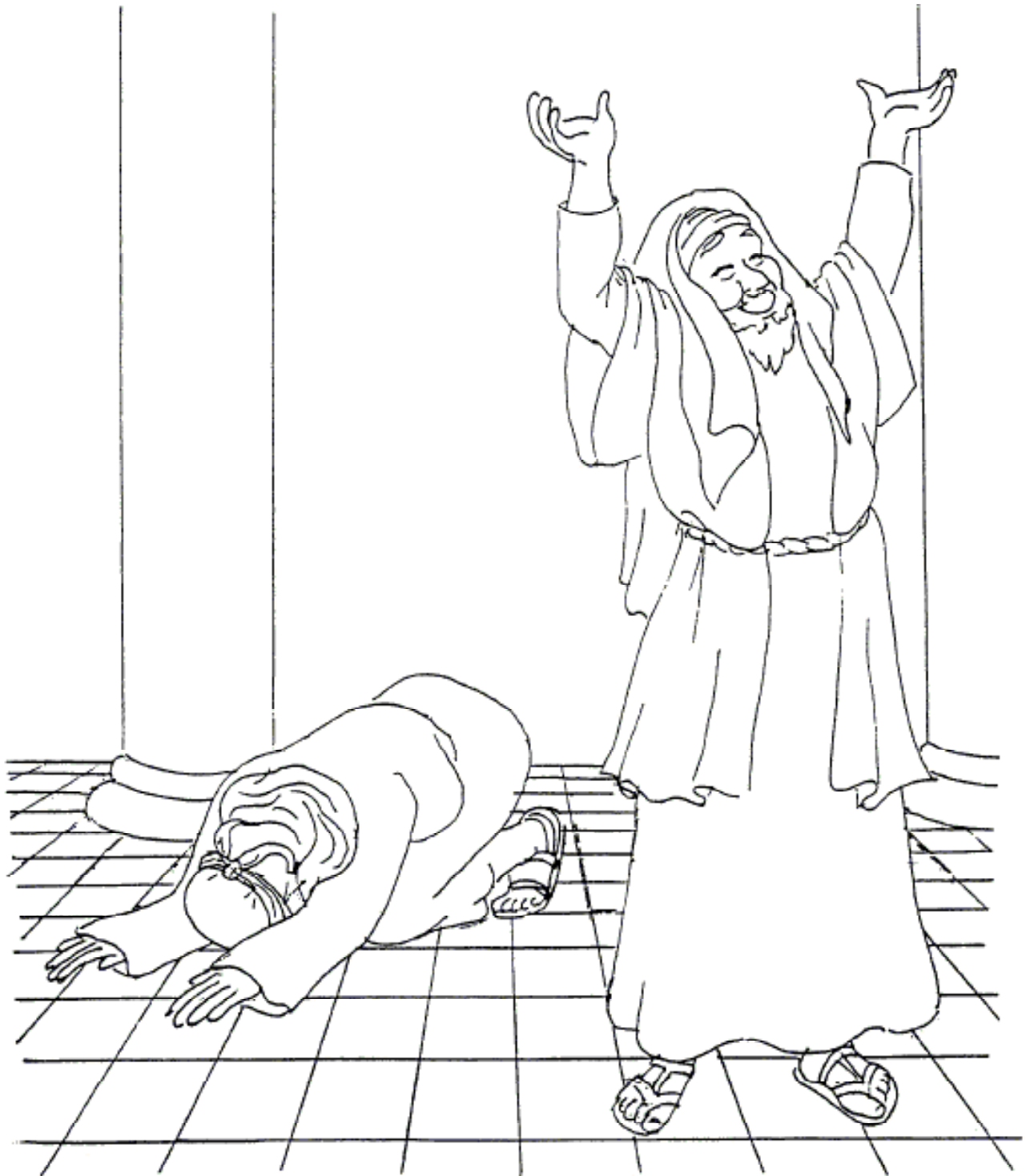

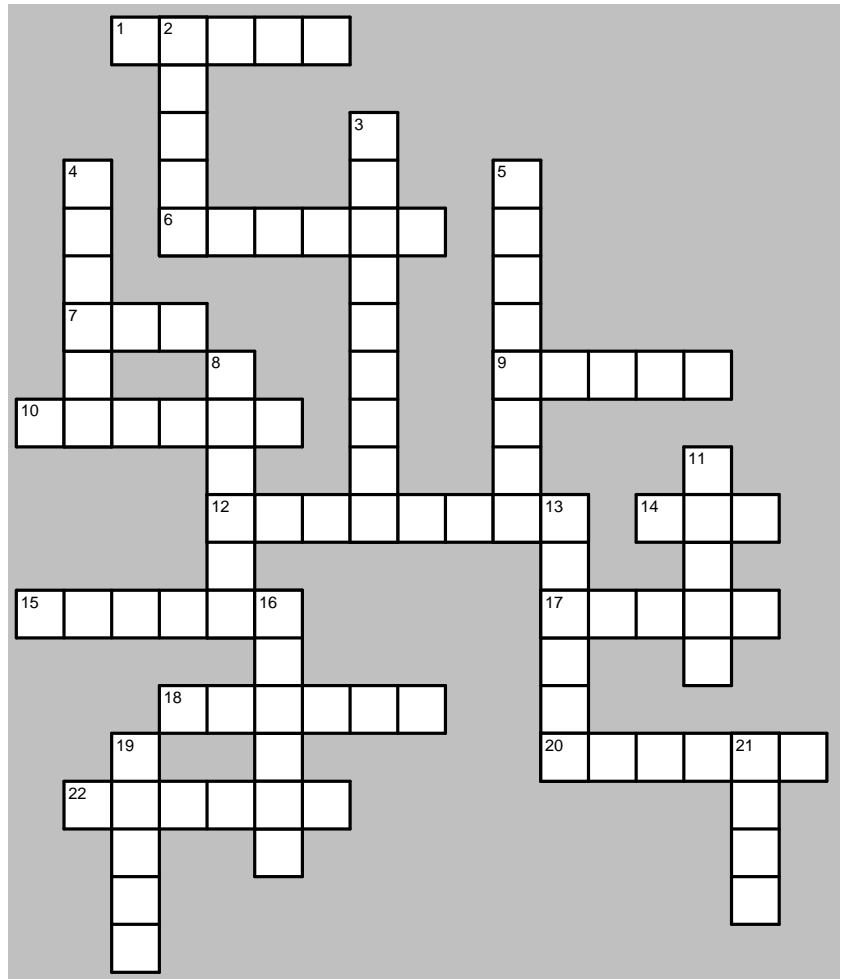
