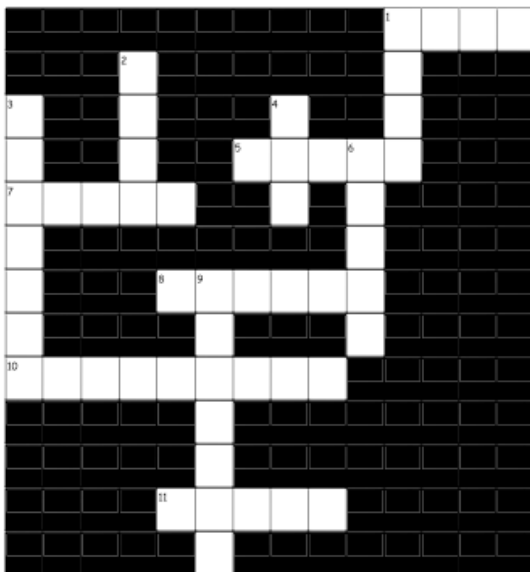
Here are some symbols that people use to help describe the Trinity, see what you think is helpful.

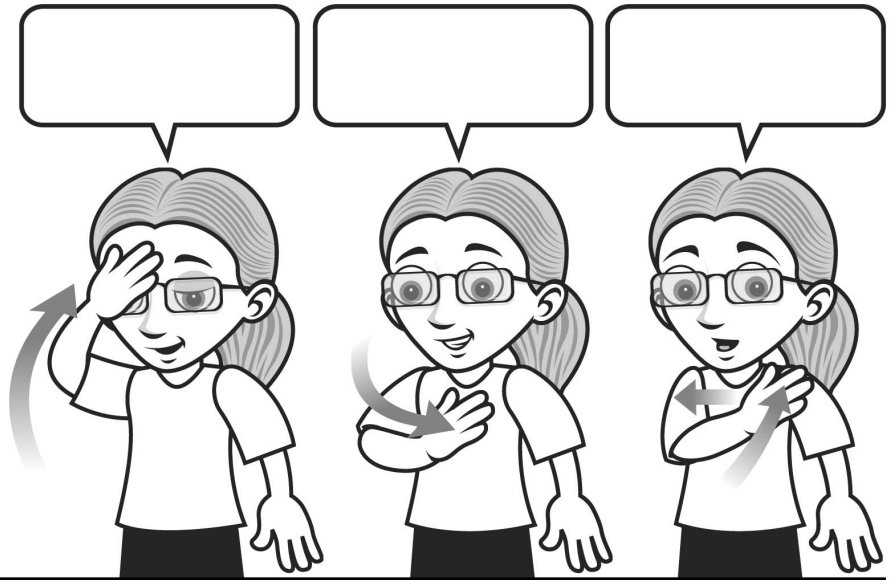

How do I make the Sign of the Cross?

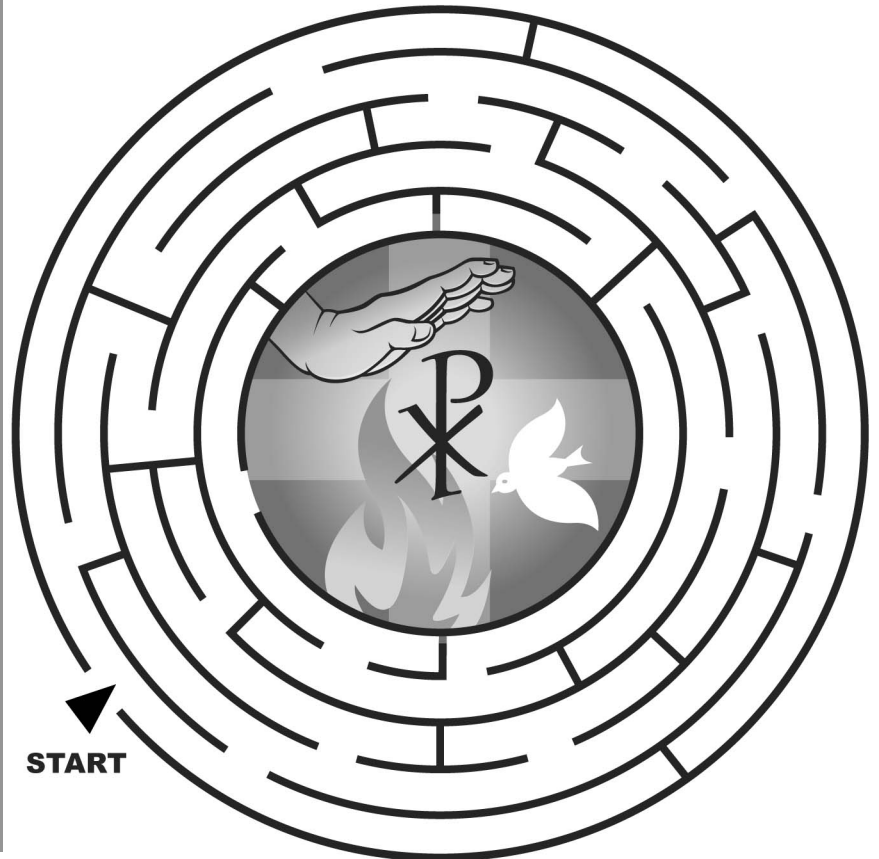
1. Using your right hand, touch your forehead and say....
