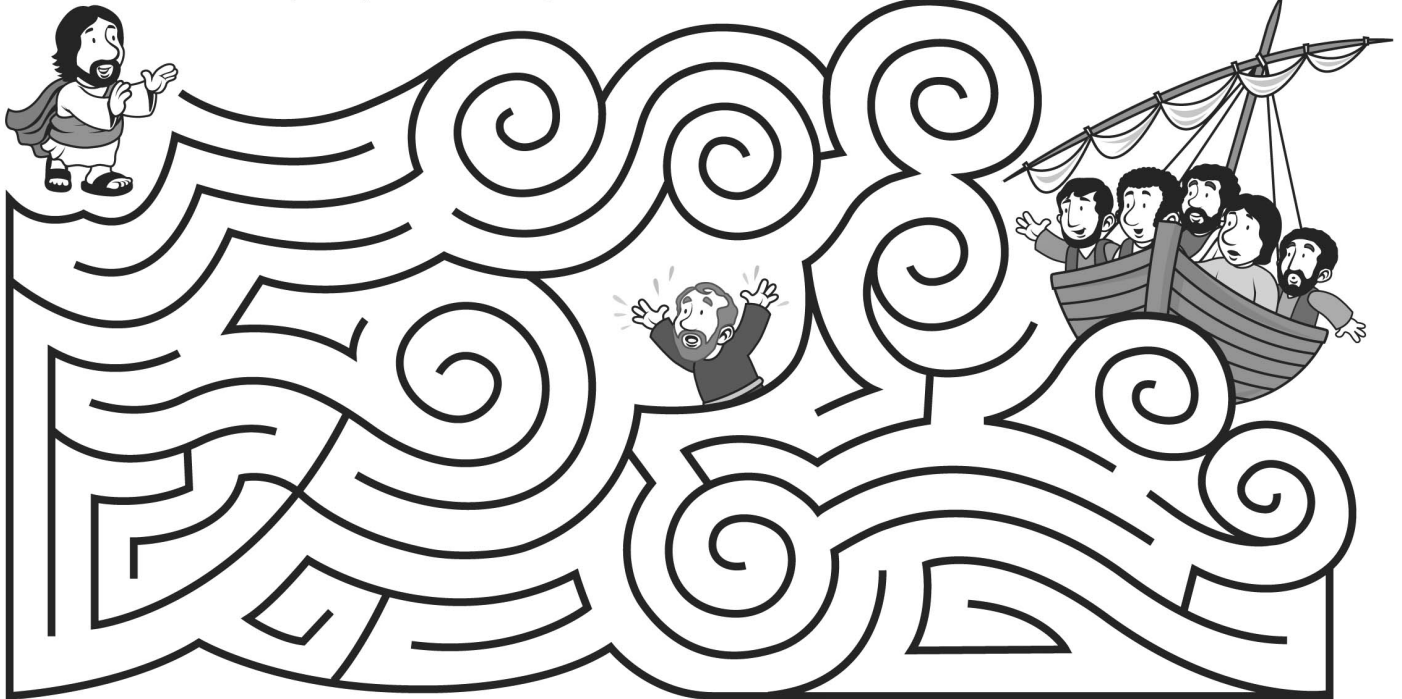


We can have faith that Jesus will always be there to help us in difficult times. Write a prayer asking God to help you when things get tough.
