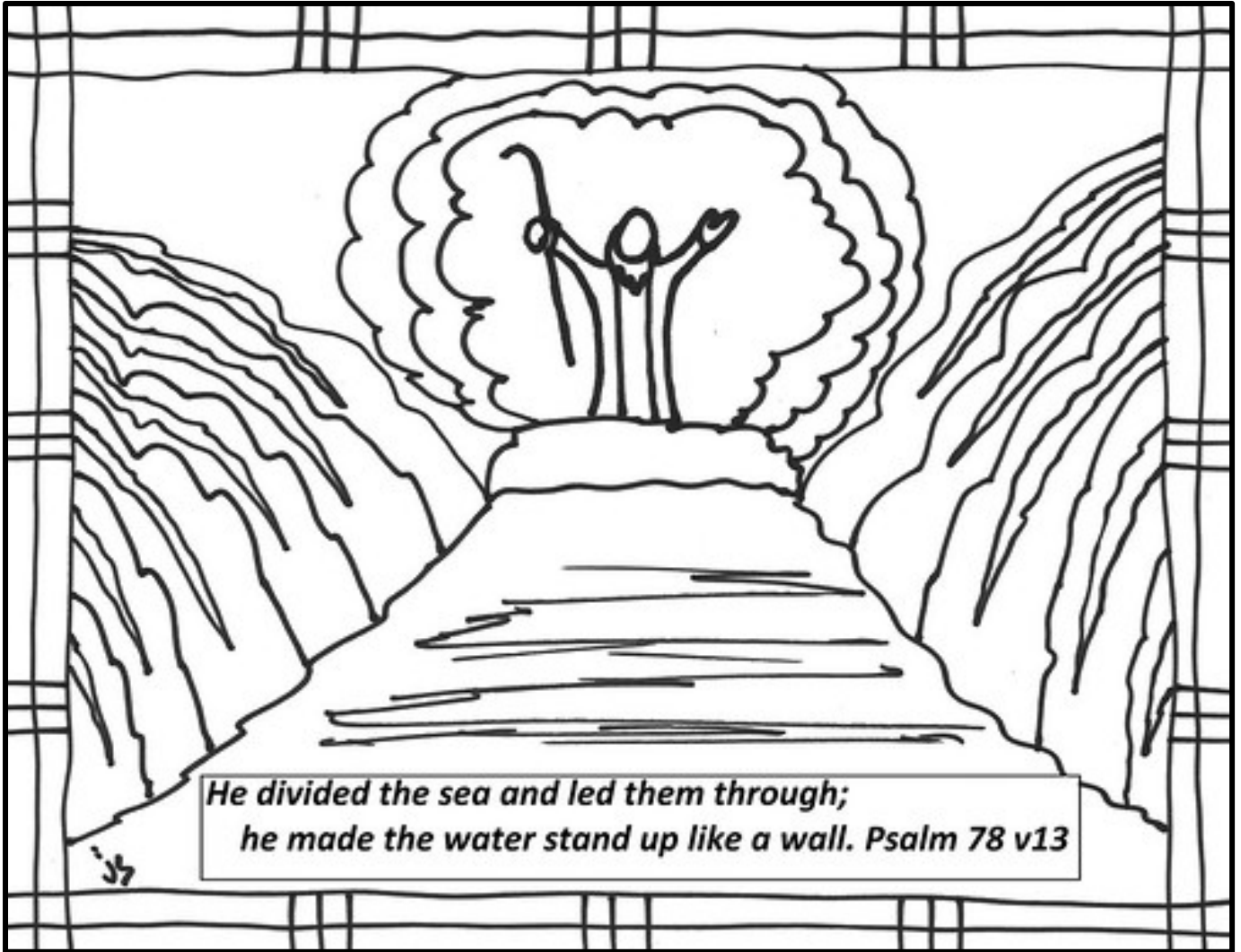

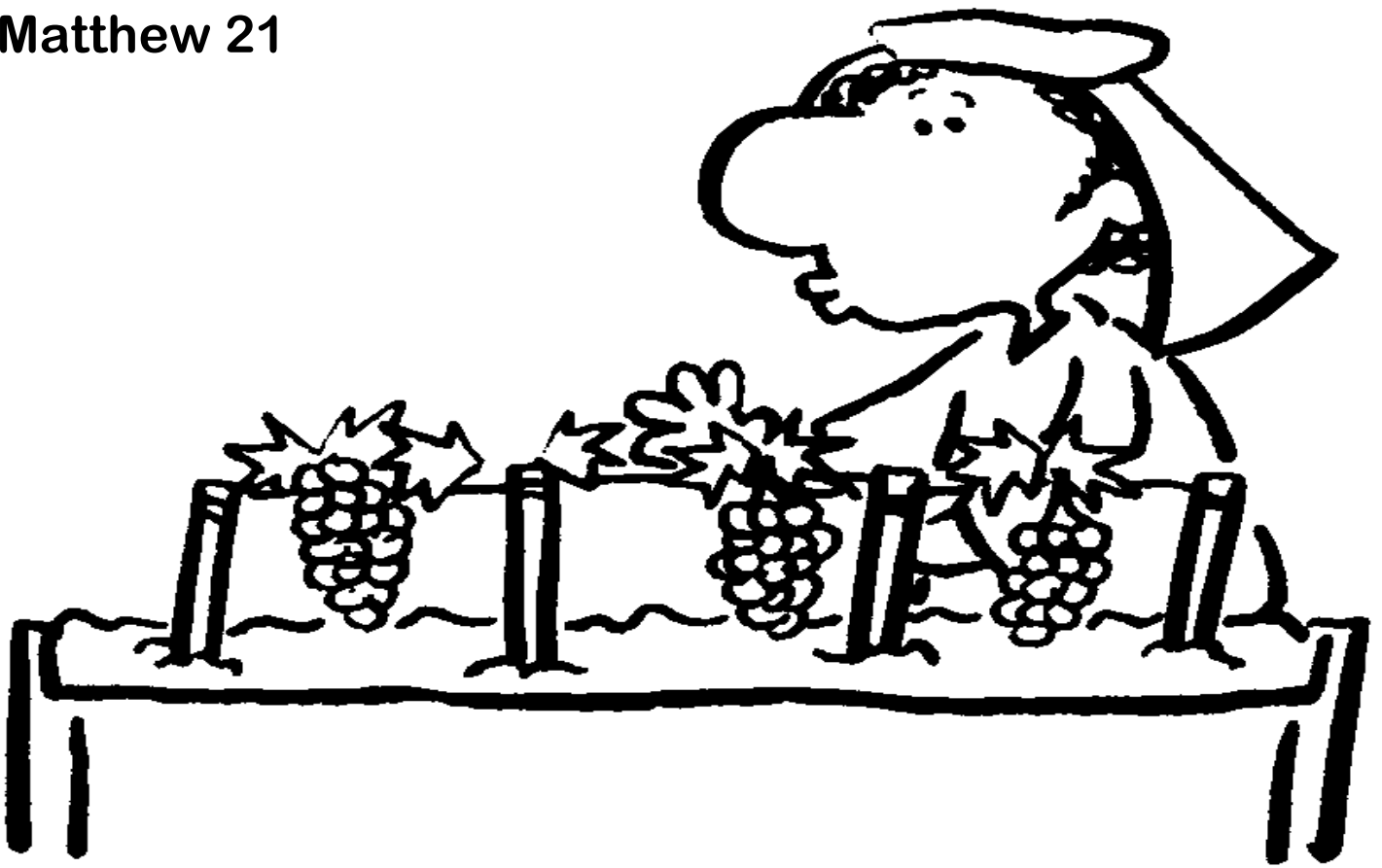

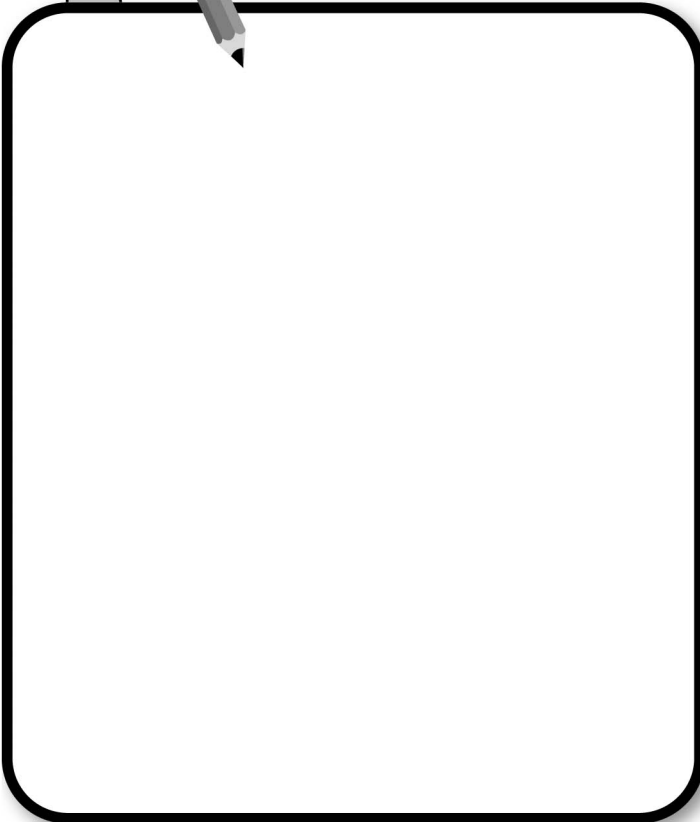

When my bedroom needs tidying, I should...



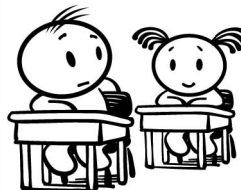
- ... go outside and play
